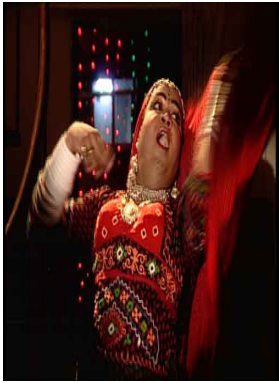
In 2007, **ASAAP** added several new staff members. For the first time, we have a Women’s Outreach and
